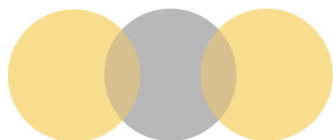

Spring Grants boost the Limestone Coast

Stand Like Stone is pleased to announce the recipients of grants from its 20th small grant round. Grant Round 20 has delivered funding to fifteen charitable projects which share in just over \$25,000, bringing the total amount of grants given to charitable projects through the Stand Like Stone “Small Grants” program to just over \$175,000.

Over the past 12 years, Stand Like Stone has grown its corpus to over \$3 million. The income earned from this corpus is distributed to the Limestone Coast community via grants and scholarships. Since its inception, Stand Like Stone has distributed over \$932,000 back to the communities of the Limestone Coast through the many programs on offer. As Stand Like Stone never spends the donations it receives, the amounts available to grant to the community will continue to grow as the amount of donations held in the trust funds grow.

In February 2017, Stand Like Stone will invite applications for its Community Capacity Building Grants program, which offers grants of up to \$20,000 for charitable projects. These grants are made available through a unique partnership with OneFortyOne Plantations Limited. Guidelines and application forms are available from the Stand Like Stone website, www.standlikestone.com.au. In August 2017, small grants of up to \$2000 will be available to the community when Stand Like Stone will invite applications for its twenty-first round of grants. Scholarships for study to be undertaken in 2018 will also open in August 2017.
